We all know that social media is important and increasingly so every day, yet many downtown businesses use it infrequently or not at all. The MDA's newly formed Tech Team is trying to remedy that, starting with an initiative focused on increasing the visibility of Metuchen's businesses on Google Maps.

So, if you see some adults and teens snapping photos at your businesses over the next few weeks, don't be alarmed. They're posting updated photos and short interior videos on each business's Google site.

And one team member is also creating entries for businesses that aren't mapped yet. How helpful is that to a business? Within a week, Google reported that 100 users had viewed the photos of one



business with newly posted content.

But an effective social media presence demands more than that. Each business has to increase its savvy in this area and commit to posting on Facebook and Instagram, and building a following.
